Gil called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Jim seconded the motion and the vote was affirmative.

**Public Participation:**

**Mike Donahue:**

Mike asked the Board to consider forming a committee to re-evaluate and study the operation of the Solid Waste Facility. The Board agreed that after nine years it is time to review again.

**Minutes of the June 25, 2013 Meeting:**

Gil motioned to accept the minutes of the June 25, 2013 Selectmen's Meeting. Jim seconded the motion and the vote was affirmative.

**Review & Sign/PA-16:**

The Board reviewed and signed the 2013 PA-16 application. This application is submitted to the Department of Revenue for reimbursement to towns and cities in which federal and state forest land is situated.

**Intergovernmental Agreement/SAU 68/Plowing:**

The Board reviewed a Memorandum of Understanding, prepared by the school district, which establishes an agreement for the plowing of the school parking lots. The Board tabled this discussion until the School Board holds a meeting with the head of both Public Works Departments to establish a more definitive agreement and until a signed copy, by the Chairman of the School Board, is provided.

**Society for the Protection of NH Forests/Digital Tax Map Information:**

The Board reviewed a letter from the Society for the Protection of NH Forests requesting that the Town give Cartographic Associates permission to release digital tax map information for the Town of Woodstock. This information will be used to map the routes of the Northern Pass Project to get a sense of the landowners directly or indirectly impacted by these towers. Gil motioned to allow Cartographic to release the digital tax map information. Joel seconded the motion and the vote was affirmative.

**Bill Johnstone/SB123/NH Electric Coop.:**

The Board reviewed SB123 and a questionnaire provided by, Bill Johnstone, New Hampshire Electric Cooperative. The Board tabled this discussion until Joel contacts Bill Johnstone for

further information.
