

Livestock Ordinance

It shall be unlawful for anyone to keep, on any parcel of land, livestock (cattle, horses, asses, sheep, goats, or pigs) in a total amount greater than three times the number of full acres of land within that parcel. For the purposes of this ordinance, every parcel of land is deemed to have a minimum of one acre.

This ordinance will become effective upon passage. Anyone found in violation of this ordinance shall have twenty days after written notification by the Town of non-compliance to remedy the violation. Thereafter, anyone continuing to violate this ordinance shall be fined not more than \$50.00 per day.
