Joel called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Gil seconded the motion and the vote was affirmative.

Public Participation:

Patrick Griffin:

Patrick explained that the Lin-Wood Ambulance Service keeps a list of town roads with directions. Patrick asked that the town notify the ambulance service anytime a new road is added.

Gagnon/Spanos/Waiver Request:

The Board reviewed a formal request for a waiver from the Board of Selectmen, in regards to the Setback Ordinance, submitted by Attorney Dolder on behalf of Carl and Linda Gagnon. Attorney Dolder is requesting a full waiver of the setback in regards to the retaining wall on Carl and Linda Gagnon's property located on Nicholson Drive. Attorney Dolder states that the waiver is necessary because it is not feasible to move the retaining wall five feet off the boundary line without impairing the integrity of the foundation of the residential structure.

Based on the recommendation of town council Gil motioned to grant the wavier without the contractor affidavit. Joel opposed. Jim seconded the motion and the vote was affirmative with opposition.
