Gil called meeting to order at 6:32 p.m. Jim seconded the motion and the vote was affirmative.

Public Participation/Mike Donahue:

Mike attended on behalf on his neighbor. His neighbor would like to know when his house is going to be added to the tax bill and when the next assessment will be done. Sandy stated that the spring bill will only reflect the land and that the assessors will pick up the house when they come back in April/May. The house will then be added to the fall tax bill and be assessed according to how much is completed.
