Trout Unlimited/Tyler Philips:

Tyler Philips, from Horizon Engineers, gave a brief overview of the Pemigewasset River Restoration Project being completed by the Pemigewasset Chapter of Trout Unlimited. He stated that this will be a 4 to 6 week project starting sometime in August or September.

Tyler met with members of the Conservation Commission following the Selectmen's Meeting to address all of their questions and concerns.

Vinny Osgood offered to be a contact person that will report back to the Board with continuous updates.

Bob Stahler/Cascade Park:
