Please realize, even though the Town buildings are closed to the public, Town employees will be available during normal business hours to assist residents and will remain fully operational.

We encourage and request all residents to process motor vehicle renewals, dog licensing, vital record requests, property taxes and water/sewer payment transactions online via www.WoodstockNH.org. We recognize that situations arise and that some town business cannot be conducted online such as marriage licenses, new motor vehicle registrations and transfers which you may schedule an appointment to complete. If you are not able to access this online option or need assistance with the online portal, we will be available by phone, email, or appointment. In-person appointment transactions will be processed outside, and masks will be required. Transactions can be completed by check or credit card only. NO CASH TRANSACTIONS.
